The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to the Eucharist – the summit and source of our Faith – here in the United States. Launched at the Feast of Corpus Christi in 2022, the USCCB initiated the Revival to focus on our role as a Eucharistic People. The Extensive plan provides a steady progression of faith and formation leading to our mission to evangelization.

YEAR OF DIOCESAN REVIVAL June 19, 2022 – June 11, 2023

This first year of the Revival invited bishops, priests, and diocesan staff to respond to the Lord's personal invitation while planning how to share this love with the faithful. The heart of the first year was to pray and fast as we asked Our Lord to revive his Church.

YEAR OF PARISH REVIVAL June 11, 2023 – July 17, 2024

The Revival is now reaching the pews! This year is about fostering Eucharistic devotion at the parish level. In anticipation of the Archdiocesan Event on Nov. 4, St. John's will host "Expose of the Sacrament of the Eucharist" by **Father Jose Kumbloickal MSFS** in Spanish on Nov. 2 and in English on Nov. 3. Both events will be at the Parish

Hall from 6:30-8 pm. In addition, on Sunday Nov.

5, at 10 a.m. the parish will have a Special Eucharistic Congress Mass with exposition of the Holy Eucharist, procession to chapel and benediction with Father Ricardo Ramirez.
