

Today's gospel passage is taken from the last supper discourse where Jesus speaks about his relationship to his disciples. In his reference to Vine and branches, he depicts Israel as the vineyard and YAWEH as the one who tends the vinevard. He proclaims himself as the Vine, and we are the branches. Without his initiative of being pruned, no branch can bear any fruit. He says that each one must bear fruit to the glory of the Father. The passage describes the intimate union that must exist between Jesus and his followers under the image of the Vine and its branches. The Lord invites us to abide in him, and he will do so again several times during his discourse. Jesus says: "As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me." Therefore, the disciples need to

abide in Jesus. Those who do not abide in him will not be able to sustain life or bear fruit, and therefore, they will be cut off.

The purpose of discipleship is to bear good fruit through mutual abiding. Disciples who do not remain in Jesus sever themselves from their life source, akin to branches that wither and die when detached from the Vine. A genuine Christian obeys Jesus' command to love their neighbor. Jesus warns that if they persist in sinful attitudes and neglect their duty as his followers, they will be severed from the life-giving Vine, Jesus himself. This renders them useless, fit only to be thrown into the fire and burnt. Conversely, disciples who abide in Jesus and maintain an intimate union with him, will have their prayers answered by the Father. The gospel passage assures us that if we remain in him, we can ask for anything and experience God's generosity. May the Lord bless you and your family.
