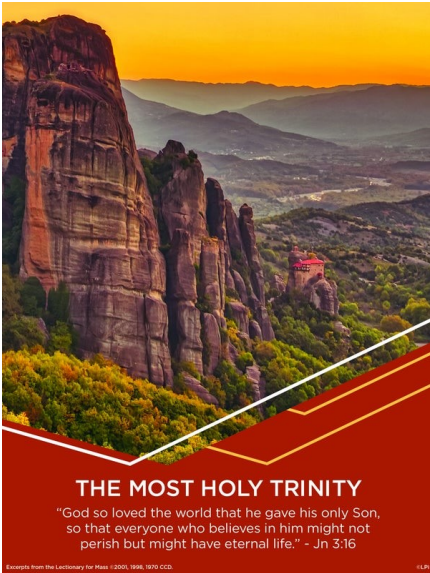

## The Most Holy Trinity



### THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

"God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." - Jn 3:16

the world that he gave his only Son." God gives Himself to us completely. This is the model for our lives.

As Christian stewards, we are called to respond in the same way — by giving ourselves back to God and to others. Stewardship is not simply about managing resources. It is about self-gift. It is about living a life that reflects the love of the Trinity.

This means offering our time in service, our talents in ministry, and our treasure in support of the Church's mission. It means living in relationship — with God and with one another — in a spirit of generosity and love.

The more we live this way, the more we grow in intimacy with God. The more we give ourselves, the more we experience "the grace of the Lord, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit" in our lives.

Today, let us reflect on the love of this Triune God. And let us respond by striving to live lives of self-giving love through the stewardship way of life. ©Catholic Stewardship Consultants

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity — the central mystery of our Christian faith. While the Trinity is beyond our full understanding, it reveals something essential for us as Christian stewards. The Trinity is a communion of Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — who give themselves completely to one another in perfect love. This self-giving love is at the heart of the stewardship way of life.

In our first reading, God reveals Himself to Moses as "a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." The God of the universe desires to be known and to share His life with His people. This is not a distant God, but a personal and loving God. St. Paul echoes this in the second reading, reminding us that we are invited into this divine life — "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit." Through our Baptism, this divine communion already dwells within us.

In our Gospel, we hear the heart of it all: "God so loved
